

# Further Support

## Announced 5 November 2020

Following the £150 billion pounds injection from the Bank of England today, Rishi Sunak has stood up in Parliament and has announced a package of further support.

### Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme (CJRS)

- **The CJRS will now run to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2021.**
- The Government will meet 80% of the furloughed hours.
- **Employees that were employed and on the payroll on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020, who were made redundant or stopped working afterwards, can be re-employed and claimed for.** The employer must have made an RTI submission to HMRC from 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020 to 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2020, notifying a payment of earnings for those employees.

### Coronavirus Job Support Scheme (CJSS)

- The CJSS which was due to replace the CJRS **has been mothballed indefinitely** and possibly may never see the light of day. However Rishi has not discounted bringing it into play at some point.

### The Job Retention Bonus (JRB)

- The JRB of £1,000 per furloughed employee, whose employment was retained up to the end of January 2021, **has now been shelved.**

### Self-Employed Income Support Scheme

- The Government only recently increased the SEISS claim for the period November to January inclusive from 40% to 55% of the average net profits.
- **They have now increased that to 80% (maximum £7,500).**
